- Inter-city:** London and the North to Cardiff and Swansea
- Regional express:**
 - North West England to Cardiff, Swansea (via Pontyclun), Llanelli and Fishguard Harbour
 - North Wales to Cardiff via Chester, Wrexham and Shrewsbury
 - Liverpool to Bristol via Newport
 - Birmingham to Cardiff and West Wales (via Swansea District Line)
 - Portsmouth, the South West and Bristol to Cardiff, Swansea (via Vale of Galmorgan line), Llanelli, Milford Haven and Fishguard Harbour
 - Birmingham to Shrewsbury and Cambrian Coast
- Local services:**
 - Cheltenham and Bristol to Cardiff
 - Swansea to Cardiff (Swan Line)
- Valley lines:** Cardiff valleys, Penarth, Barry and the Vale of Glamorgan Line, Ebbw Vale and Abertillery to Newport and Cardiff, Maesteg to Bridgend and Cardiff and proposed service to Llantrisant and Beddau
- Heart of Wales line:** Swansea to Crewe (via Llandovery) and to Glanaman
- Other lines:** Lines not covered by this plan

The linking of routes through major interchanges such as Cardiff are indicative, rather than prescriptive.

Not all existing stations are shown, particularly on the Cardiff Valley lines and lines west of Swansea.
